## Understanding the World

Within this learning theme we will explore:

- How people from different cultures travel
- Different types of transport including those we have travelled on
- How in the past people travelled by horse and cart.
- Transport in the past and transport now.
- Creating maps from the school to the Denny.
- Maps showing the journey from Swaffham Bulbeck to Old Hunstanton.

## Expressive Arts & Design

During this term we will be exploring:

- Drawing maps
- Making boats that float and building on our design
- Making our own binoculars
- Creating pictures for class display based on the story 'We're going on a bear hunt'
- Role play
- Storytelling



## English

We will continue to participate in Sounds-Write Phonics sessions, learning the sounds made by letters of the alphabet, blending these together to read simple words, phrases and sentences, as well as having an increased focus on segmenting to spell and simple sentence writing. We will use our developing skills to write. Our topic will be taught primarily through our English sessions. We will look closely at different stories based on transport. We will create story maps based on 'the text 'We're going on a bear hunt' and then create our own versions using different characters and settings. We will then write in full sentences our own version of the story, using vocabulary we have used in our play. The children will write lists, a recount and sentences using adjectives,



## Maths

This half term we will begin focusing on:

Consolidating previous learning

Naming, describing and sorting 2D shapes

Estimating

Halving and sharing

Learning how to use a Rekenrek

Exploring how 5 is composed

Exploring how 6,7,8 and 9 are composed looking at how 5 is a part of them.



## R.E. Christianity

This half term we are considering ways to care for the wonderful world God created for us. We will be discussing ways of re-cycling and re-using materials. We will be reading 'Wonderful Earth' as a tool to remind us of how amazing planet earth is, and how it is important that we do our best to look after it.



## PSHE

This half term we will be focussing on healthy and safer lifestyles and keeping safe through:

- Developing strategies to keep ourselves safe if lost
- To understand how to apply safety rules in different contexts e.g. sun, water, fire
- To understand basic road safety skills
- To be able to identify common harmful substances

We will also be naming different parts of the body including the external 'private' parts and identify between different touches e.g. hugs, cuddles, pushing and hitting (Reception children only)



## PE

During PE we will be continuing learning athletic skills in preparation for sports day, and swimming including water confidence, **Please note swimming sessions will be for reception children only!**



## Forest School

As we benefit from the warmer weather this half term, we will be enjoying outdoor activities including planting, weaving and creating mini-beasts. We will be using our observational skills to recognise how our environment changes as the seasons change. We will be using the fire-pit and learning how to light the fire safely.
