	<p>We strongly advise parents to wear a face covering on-site or at drop off and pick up.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• As of July 19th, face coverings are no longer required. We recommend parents wear masks in and around school premises.</li> </ul>				
	<p><b>Close Contacts and Isolation</b> Children no longer have to self-isolate if they are contacted by NHS Track &amp; Trace. They are encouraged to take a PCR test as soon as possible. They should isolate whilst they are waiting on result of PCR test. If they test positive, they will have to isolate as before.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Classes no longer have to close due to a single positive case. Track and Trace will determine close contacts and send appropriate message to those people.</li> <li>• Contact tracing is no longer required to be undertaken by schools</li> <li>• As before, those showing symptoms of COVID, will be required to self-isolate and undertake a PCR test.</li> <li>• Adults who have had both doses of vaccination are no longer required to isolate if “pinged” by track and trace as a close contact.</li> </ul>				
	<p>There will extra handwashing and surfaces will be cleaned regularly throughout the day.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Individual towels are no longer needed.</li> <li>• Donations of soap and tissues are warmly received!</li> </ul>
