Summer Term Curriculum Map Year 3/4

History & Geography



In History, we will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians. We will use sources of evidence to learn about pyramids, gods and goddesses.

In Geography, we will be exploring the importance of the River Nile and its human and physical features.

P.E

In PE, we will be developing our ball skills building up to playing small games as well as athletics. Later in the term, our swimming lessons will begin focusing on water confidence and technique.

PSHE

This term, we will be looking at drug education, in particular, medicines. We will begin our Relationships and Sex Education unit looking at the physical differences between males and females and naming body parts.

Science

In Science, will be learning about magnets. We will explore magnetic forces looking at attraction and repulsion. Later in the term, we will explore sound including how sounds are made, vibrations, pitch and volume.

Maths



This term, we will be focusing on shape, space and measure units. This will include calculating the area, time, statistics, 2D/3D shape and their properties and money.
